

## JUNIOR PERMISSION TO SKATE 2022-23 SEASON Information Sheet

This information sheet is for 15 and 16-year-old players who are planning to attend Junior team camps or tryouts. The Hamilton Jr. Bulldogs can only issue Permission To Skate "PTS" to OMHA Centre players who reside in the City of Hamilton (Ancaster, Caledonia, Dundas, Flamborough, Glanbrook, Hagersville and Stoney Creek).

Any player who played for the Hamilton Jr. Bulldogs U16 or U18 team that were on an F1 waiver or who reside in the "Old City of Hamilton" borders Hamilton Huskies boundary must reach out to there home center to obtain the PTS document.

Players **MUST** complete a **PTS** form for each individual Junior Club they wish to attend. If you plan on attending 5 Junior Hockey Camps, then you must have 5 separate completed PTS forms.

Before emailing the form, please ensure all "Player Info" sections are filled in with correct information along with the Team Name of the Junior Club you plan to attend tryouts/camps for. Incomplete forms will not be signed by the Hamilton Jr. Bulldogs. The PTS form can be found here:

We will do our best to accommodate all requests, however, please do not wait for the day of the tryout to request your Junior Permission to Skate Form. Once the Junior Permission Form is signed, you will receive the completed form by email sent to the email address that you sent your request from.

## **Some Important Information**

## U16 (2006) 16 Year Old's

- ≈ Jr. C teams may only have <u>local 16-year-old players</u> in their tryouts
- ≈ Local 16-year-olds who participate at C are not eligible to affiliate with Jr. A and B teams
- ≈ 16-year-olds who participate in U18 AAA hockey are eligible to affiliate for 10 games with a Jr. B or A team and Major Junior team.
- ≈ Tryout Progression for Junior Hockey Junior Teams must release 16-year-old players from their camps by the following dates except for those they have signed
  - OHL Teams must release 16-year old's not signed with 48 hours of the start of training camp
  - Junior A and B teams must release 16-year-olds not signed by midnight a week from the Friday of Labour Day Weekend
  - Junior C teams must release local 16-year-olds not signed by midnight two weeks from the Friday of Labour Day Weekend
